

transferred to "H" Division, serving at Halifax, New Glasgow and Pictou before leaving the Force on January 22, 1941, and becoming Chief of the New Glasgow Police. On September 22, 1941, he joined the Canadian Provost Corps and served overseas until 1946, attaining the rank of captain. On April 5, 1946, he re-engaged in the Force at Fredericton, N.B., and was posted to "J" Division. Subsequent postings took him to Sussex, Moncton, Fredericton, Ottawa in "A" Division, and Rockcliffe in "N" Division. He was discharged to pension on October 3, 1954.

6093, ex-Cpl. Sydney Howard Moseley, 83, died January 15, 1979, at Edmonton, Alta. He was born January 22, 1895, at Cannock, England, and joined the Force on September 3, 1914, at Mcleod, Alta. In 1916 he left the Force but re-engaged in 1918 at Edmonton. During his career he served at Regina, Sask., Calgary, Lethbridge and Edmonton, Alta. He retired to pension on June 30, 1946, having been promoted corporal on April 1, 1941, while in "K" Division.

11714, ex-S/Sgt. Douglas Richard Woodsworth Mason, 81, died January 21, 1979, at Edmonton, Alta. He was born July 17, 1897, at Croyden, England, and served in the Rajput Light Infantry between 1915 and 1923, where he attained the rank of captain. On January 11, 1932, he joined the Alberta Provincial Police and was sworn into the RCMP on April 1, 1932, when the A.P.P. was absorbed. During his career with the Force he was stationed at Edmonton and Vegreville, Alta., and Regina, Sask. He was promoted corporal on February 1, 1941, sergeant on June 1, 1947, and staff sergeant on October 1, 1949. He was discharged to pension on October 2, 1955.

C/Supt. Thomas Austin Horn (Rtd.), 66, died January 16, 1978, at Victoria, B.C. He was born December 6, 1911, at

Marieton, Saskatchewan, and joined the RCMP on November 8, 1934, at Regina as regimental number 12488. Following recruit training, he was posted to the musical ride, remaining at Depot until March 31, 1938, when he purchased his discharge to join the CPR Police. On February 6, 1939, he re-joined the Force at Vancouver, was transferred to Calgary, Radium Hot Springs, then back to Calgary, where he was promoted corporal on November 1, 1945, and sergeant on May 1, 1951. On March 1, 1954, while NCO i/c C.I.B. at Calgary, he was promoted sub-inspector and transferred to "F" Division, as the O.I.C. Regina Sub-Division. On March 1, 1956, promoted inspector, he was posted to "E" Division in Victoria as the D.P.O. In 1959, he was posted to Edmonton Sub-Division, and in 1963 to "A" Division in Ottawa, as the O.I.C. Criminal Investigation Branch, where he remained for a year until becoming the D.P.O. for HQ, "G", "N" and Air Divisions. In 1965, he was promoted superintendent and made the Senior Personnel Officer in HQ, a post he kept until September 15, 1967, when he was promoted chief superintendent and transferred to "B" Division as the commanding officer. C/Supt. Horn retired to pension on September 14, 1970.

6654, ex-Cst. Alfred Arthur Watson, 82, died May 10, 1979, at Regina. He was born October 28, 1896, at London, England, and joined the RNWMP on February 22, 1917, at Regina. One year later, at the end of his term, he left the Force and joined the Lord Strathcona Horse Regiment at Calgary.

14486, ex-Sgt. John William Tomelin, 58, died May 19, 1979, at Jacksonville, Florida. He was born October 26, 1921, at Buchanan, Saskatchewan, and joined the RCMP on May 15, 1942, at Calgary. Following part I training at Regina, he was transferred to "N" Division at Rockcliffe for part II training before being sent to Moncton Sub-
