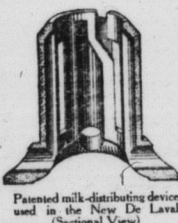

If a farmer saves an hour a week by being enabled to use good roads as opposed to bad roads, it would mean 52 hours a year.
