Housing Commission
Organized in Galt

A report in the Galt Reporter on the Housing situation and Housing Commission says:

"Galt is today in possession of a Housing Commission and can heartily congratulate herself on that fact. She is one of the first to accept the conditions named by the Provincial Government and will be one of the first to undertake the construction of Workingmen's houses according to the plan outlined in put in depositories the savings of

hundreds, even thousands of citizens, and from these depositors will be drawn whatever sums are required for the purpose. But the Provincial Act, based as it is on the principle of the greatest good to the greatest number, lacks nothing in generous provisions. It is expecially framed to meet the call from the returned soldier whose purse is not full. But it is an excellent all-round measure and the stimulus it will give to the erection of moderate-sized, compact and sanitary houses for workingmen will largely solve the problem for growing municipalities. We are shouldering ourselves with a clear-cut enterprise that is regarded by hardheaded business men as fundamentally sound. It is in accord with the spirit of the times as noted in most of the co-operative movements of the co-operative movements of day. Further culogistic com-nt on either the provisions of Act or the motives actuating the Act or the motives actuating its authors, is quite unnecessary. It ihas successfully run the gauntlet of professional, municipal and legislative criticism and that is sufficient to secure for it the confidence and approval of our people. Projected as the plan has been in Galt, The Reporter sees only the achievement of the aims of its promoters to a degree that will prove satisfactory all round. The City Council has selected four well-known citizens to serve on the Housing Commission—Alex R. Goldie, John H. Hancock, N.E. Palmer and Charles Cumming—and initial opera-H. Hancock, N.E. Palmer and Char-les Cumming—and initial opera-tions are, therefore, not likely to be long delayed.
