KENNY, THOS. F. (*Restigouche.*)

S. of Michael Kenny, of County Wexford, Irel., who emigrated to Bathurst, Co. Gloucester, 1845. A tailor by trade. B. in Bathurst, Gloucester Co., 1847. M. 1873 to Helen Pritchard, of New Richmond, dau. of Ralph Pritchard, Co. Bonaventure, P.Q. Descended from an English family; grandf. one of the English Loyalists; a captain in the English army, settled in New Richmond, Bonaventure, P.Q. Is High School Trustee for Parish of Dalhousie, and has held office for six years; is also Overseer of the Poor. A tanner and currier; engaged in the manufacture of leather for last ten years. First returned to Parlt. at last g.e. A Liberal Conservative.—*Dalhousie, Restigouche, N.B.*

KILLAM, AMASA EMERSON, J. P. (*Westmoreland.*)

Great-grandf. on father's side was an officer in the British army; served during the Am revolution, and upon the United States having secured their independence, came to this Province and settled in Sackville. Grandparents on mother's side were also Loyalists, and settled at Sackville after the close of the war. B. 25 Aug. 1834. Ed. at the Common School. M. 25 July 1857, at Sackville, N.B., Melicent Wheaton. Held the office of Postmaster for several years, and is now Presdt. and Manager of the Albert Railway. First elected at last g.e. A Liberal Conservative. Believes in Protection, particularly for goods that can be manufactured in this country. Fully believes in the National Policy, and that it is the only policy that will secure the reciprocity of trade with the United States, which has been so much sought after for some years.—*Moncton, N.B.*

Of Acadian descent. S. of A. Landry, Esq., who sat for Westmoreland in N.B. Assembly from 1846, almost uninterruptedly, up

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
