limited to the laying down across the same, (that is in the line of the said Branch or continuation, at whatever angle it may intersect such highway,) the rails and other contrivances forming part of the Railroad, subject to the limitations mentioned in the 5 section, or any other part of this Act.

XV. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for the said Company may Company to take, use, occupy and hold, but not to alienate, so &c. much of the public beach or beach road, or of the land covered with the waters of the River St. Lawrence and of the River 10 Richelieu, or Lake Champlain, as may be required for the wharves and other works of the said Branch or continuation, and other works, which they are heroby authorized to construct, not more than two hundred yards in length, nor more than one hundred and fifty yards in breadth, doing no damage to nor causing any 15 obstruction in the navigation of the said rivers: Provided always, Provise. that such land shall not be taken, or any such wharf or work erected thereon, except by permission of the Governor of the Province, and in accordance with any conditions he shall think proper to impose, nor shall any land vested in the Principal Officers of

20 Her Majesty's Ordnance be taken without their consent.

XVI.
