I.—REGULATION AND MANAGEMENT OF THE
HOUSE.

1. The Time for the Ordinary Meeting of ^{Time of} The House is at Three o'clock in the after-^{Meeting.} noon of each sitting day, and if at that hour there be not a Quorum, Mr. Speaker may take the Chair and adjourn. When The House rises on Friday, it shall stand adjourned, unless otherwise ordered, until the following Monday.

2. If at the hour of Six o'clock, p.m., the ^{Evening} Business of the Day be not concluded, ^{Sittings.} Mr. Speaker shall leave the Chair until half-past Seven.

3. When the House adjourns, the Mem- ^{Order in} bers shall keep their seats until The Speaker ^{adjourn-} has left the chair. ^{ments.}
