And whereas, in the curing of Cod fish, Ling, and The Master Of Eake, considerable Quantities of Salt are necessarily fel with Fish coming from thrown over them, when hipped, to preserve them from Newfoundland, spoiling, and a great Part thereof falls off in unloading all the fool Salt on board, the Clessel, and it hath been too common a Practice in the Prefor the Dwner or Master of the Aestel, and People Salt Officer. belonging thereto, to collect fuch loofe and foul Salt together, and clandeffinely convey it on Shoze, and fell it at an under Plice, whereby bis Bajeng's Revenue has been considerably injured; be it therefore enacted, That from and after the paming of this Ac, the waller of every deffel laden with Cod fish, Ling, or bake, either coming from Newfoundland, the North Seas, or Iceland, or the Gulph of Saint Lawrence, or the Coast of Labrador, into any Port or Place in Great Britain, thall, and is bereby required to throw, or cause to be thrown, overboard, and destroyed, all the Salt that thall to fall off, or be in the Aestel, at the Time of the unloading of landing of all of any Part of ber Cargo, in the Pzefence of an Officer foz the Duties on Salt; and if the Master of luch Clessel thall ne Penalty on lest of refuse to to do, it shall and may be lawful to and Neglect 20%. for the Salt Officer on Board, by himself, or with such amnance as may be necessary, to throw all and every Part thereof overboard, or otherwise defirog the same, and the Matter, for luch Megled or Refusal, Shall forfeit the Sum of Ewenty Pounds, and Coffs; and if any tuch Salt thall be landed or run on Shore, the fame, and every Part thereof, hall be fogfeited, and Creble the Clalue thereof; and all and every Person Persons in and Persons in whose Eustody the same shall be found, such Salt is and all and every Person and Persons who is, are, of forfeit 201. thall be aiding or affishing in the Landing or Running thereof, that forfeit the like Sum of Ewenty Pounds, and Colls; Die Woiety of all which Fozfeitures thall Forfeitures be to the are of his Majelty, his beirs and Suc- plied. reffois, and the other Wolety to luch Officer og Officers who shall seize, prosecute, or inform for the same; to be recovered and levied in such Wanner and Fozm, and with such Power of Hitigation, as any Fine, Foz-16 F feiture,
