Dear Sir:-

Your letter of August 11th - 7061, has been received, ~~also~~ enclosing one to your Agent in Sydney. I would like to point out the following:-

- (1) The Reservation is a very small one, and the housing very inadequate.
- (2) There are about 125 Indians on the Reservation.
- (3) That earth closets, or any such substitute for proper sanitary arrangements would be entirely unsatisfactory.

I would therefore ask your Department to make such sanitary arrangements as would prevent this Reservation from being a menace to the health of the Indians themselves, as well as to the locality in which it is located. It has long been a source of worry to us, and we feel that the Government, should at least, make it sanitary.
