Council has excepted to have Resol<sup>n</sup> of H. O. C. carried out in  
the Irish Dept<sup>t</sup> of the Post. - A committee of the Council applied to come  
into the matter, such as after investigating all circumstances reported  
that from the official documents they found the resol<sup>n</sup> was not  
carried out in any of the Irish Dep<sup>t</sup>s & reported council to  
take action.

1892. May 1st.

Resolved that, 1892 May 1<sup>st</sup>. shall be strictly enforced in  
all post contracts entered into in Ireland - condemn Irish Dept<sup>t</sup>  
for not enforcing the resol<sup>n</sup> in this. - Matter in abeyance  
so far as nothing done. ~~except~~ again taken up by the Council  
allied to the members of the Post. No labour & Post Act's various  
Trade Councils in Post & Ireland were directed to the non  
compliance of the Irish Dept<sup>t</sup>. General Trade councils adopted  
our resol<sup>n</sup>: members of Post promised compliance

Resol<sup>n</sup> states, that large part of the body regd of the  
Dept<sup>t</sup> Irish Dep<sup>t</sup>s is carried out by boys, other underfed labor,  
<sup>(partly)</sup> also condemn subdealing by Govt - public ad<sup>r</sup>: many Irish  
workmen (underfed) produced unskillful & bad - gross labor. &  
in one quarter less bulldogged in discipline would render considerable  
useless of Govt & other public ad<sup>r</sup>:

Skelekin Trades Council passed above Resol<sup>n</sup> also  
Post officials informed. Mr Inspector General R. J. G. and Chief  
Const<sup>l</sup> of the Metropolian Police, have also endorsed the carryout  
of the fair w. clause, have already caused the removal of  
work wh had hitherto been done by boys & encouraged to be  
given to fair employees - done by competent tradesmen.  
Mr. Morley has written to say re boy labor that it is a bad bad concern
