Council has sought to have Resolⁿ of H. of C. carried out in
the Irish Dept^s of the Post. - A committee of the Council applied & came
into the matter, such: after investigating the circumstances referred
that from the official documents they found the Resolⁿ was not
carried out in any of the Irish Dept^s & requested Council to
take action.

1892. They did.

Resolⁿ that, R. of H. of C. 13th Feb. shall be strictly enforced in
all post contracts, entered into in Ireland & condemn Irish Dept^s
for not enforcing the Resolⁿ in this. - matter in subsequent

Trade Councils in Dublin & Ireland were directed to the non
compliance of the Irish Dept^s. Several trade councils adopted
our Resolⁿ: members of Post promised assistance
