Extracts from the Rules and Regulations of the Club relating to Honorary Membership.

"Honorary and temporary Members admitted under this rule shall be entitled, without payment of entrance fee or subscription, to the privileges of the Club, except those of attending meetings of the Club, or of proposing or seconding or voting for candidates for election, and shall, save as aforesaid, be subject to the rules and restrictions applicable to ordinary Members."—*Extract from Rule XIII.*

The Club-house is open every day for the reception of Members at Half-past Eight o'clock in the forenoon, and is shut at Twelve o'clock midnight.

No Member shall give any money or gratuity to any of the Servants.

All Members must pay their Bills for every expense they incur in the Club before they leave the house, the Steward having positive orders not to open accounts with any person.

No persons are admitted into the Club-house but Members, and Honorary Members individually invited by the Committee, or persons calling upon them, or upon business connected with the Club. No stranger is admitted to view the house, unless accompanied by a Member, and between the hours of Twelve and Three o'clock P.M.

Subject to certain regulations Members can invite a guest to dinner any evening, and to luncheon on Saturdays and Sundays.
