MEMORANDUM FOR DR. SKELTON

TRANSMISSION OF COPIES OF WAR DEPARTMENT
REGULATIONS, PRESS RELEASES AND OTHER
DOCUMENTS TO THE LEGATIONS

I. Mr. Christie has requested that arrangements be made to keep the Legation at Washington supplied with copies of all Regulations, Orders, Press Releases, Reports, etc., which are not of a confidential nature, published by the Censorship Coordination Committee, the War Time Prices and Trade Board, the Public Information Committee, the Voluntary Service Registration Bureau, the War Supply Board and other Boards, Bureaux or Departments that may issue such documents on matters connected with Canada's war effort.

II. It would appear to be desirable that such documents should, in most cases, be forwarded not only to Washington but also to our other representatives abroad.

III. It is I assume desirable that the documents in question should be forwarded through the Department of External Affairs and not directly by the issuing body.
