four Schools in operation among the Indians of your Agency, namely, me at St. Regis where you reade, another at the Cherrand, and here on bornwall Island-one of the lather is a Roman Catholicans the other a Probestant melitutions the lather being conducted under the auspices of the methodist Church. The report from the three last Schools are Sam glad today. on the whole satisfactory; but \$ regret that I cannot say as much for the School at St. Reges you should use your whereat efforts to induce the framents of the Indian children to send them to these Institutions, and the Returns of the attendance at the Schools should be forwarded by
