Before granting her discharge the Department would like some information regarding the Indian she proposes to marry. You should give his name, occupation, if any, also his prospects for making a comfortable home for this girl. In this connection I beg to refer you to circular letter sent you on July 2nd last, which outlined the Department's policy with regard to the discharge of pupils.
