Sir,

In reply to your letter of 19th instant No. 105 G, I have to inform you that it is customary for Inspectors in the North West Territories to furnish support vouchers for all items of expenditure over one dollar, and also to accompany their account with a diary. Your predecessors in the office of Assistant Indian Commissioner have always followed this rule, and it is desirable that you will conform to it in the future.

With reference to accountable advances I would say that following the usual custom it would be advisable in future to have the Commissioner requisition for all these advances for yourself and his staff.
