At 2230 hrs on 14 Feb 45 I went to my home with my husband, Sully & Louis met me in the garden, the witness recognizes Gnr Sullivan as Sully and Gnr La Place as Louis. The accused persons came into the house with me and the accused Sullivan said that they were celebrating his birthday. I provided some small glasses and we drank rum. Sully (Gnr Sullivan) gave us each a glass of rum. Sully had a small bottle, about the size of a lemonade bottle, and four half drinks were poured, and a small quantity was left in the bottle. I gave both the accused persons some coffee and something to eat and they left the house, at 2345 hrs. The next morning at 0800 hrs Sully (Gnr Sullivan) came to my home and asked me to state to an Officer who would be coming for a statement that I had been in her house the whole evening the night of ~~the~~ 14 Feb 45, he stated he was confined to barracks and that he did not have permission to leave.
