is also likely to be swept away in the course of time when it comes in direct touch with Lake Superior by means of the great canal that is more than the imaginary scheme in the minds of those captains of industry who have had the shoping of its past to a large extent.

In a very few years, therefore, it is but a mild statement of fact to say that the whole face of the Canadian West will come under a process of transformation as startling as has been the change in Manitoba since its first beginnings at the hands of the Selkirk settlers and the indomitable enterprise of the Hudson's Bay traders.

Winnipeg pulsates responsively to nll this environment of energy and to-day there are among the opportunities for the employment of capital and labor that always bring up the near guard of railway development exceptional openings in this eity alone for industrial energy. These are being eagerly overhauled by American enterprise where local capital and skilled labor are found insufficient. This great centre from which so much vitality radiates with daily increasing momentum offers an unquestionably bright prospect to British capital and the expert workman of the Motherland.
