sticky, the membranes of the nose look dusty, and ulcers or spots are visible if closely examined. The glands under the back of the ears and between the jaws are hard, hunpy and swollen.

In addition to the above symptoms, Farcy affects the skin by producing swellings, or nodules, varying from

the size of a pea to that of a hickory nut (ealled Farcy buds, or Farcy buttons), which are found inside of the hind legs under the abdomen, on the side of the chest, shoulder and neck, also around the nose, lips and face. Generally there is a discharge of greenish-yellow pus, which is very sticky.
