- 10.00 A.M.—Arrival at the Port of Quebec of the Royal Yacht bearing 'Rex', King of the Mardi Gras, and his suite.—Royal salute of 21 gnus from Dufferin Terrace.
- 10.30 A.M.—Procession of the King through the streets of Quebec in his Royal Car, accompanied by the various guards and followed by summer and winter vehicles, automobiles and floats.
- 11.00 A.M.—Reception of the King by the Mayor of Quebec and his Conneil at the City Hall.—Presentation of an address, and the Golden Key of the "Ancient City of Champlain".
