Biblical Knowledge

Residences for Men and Women

are essential features of the Trinity system, and an important means of education.

St. Hilda's College

is the RESIDENCE FOR THE WOMEN STUDENTS of the University, who attend lectures with the men. This residence is ON THE TRINITY GROUNDS.

Scholarships and Prizes

at matriculation and in the undergraduate course are open to WOMEN AND MEN ALIKE.

8 Matriculation Scholarships

carry with them free tuition for the whole course. ONLY TWO CONDITIONS are attached. Winners must reside and must pass their subsequent examinations well. The examination is held at the High Schools in July.

Bursaries and Exhibitions

are offered, especially to sons of clergymen, in the faculties of ARTS AND DIVINITY.

Special Courses

are provided in all the subjects of the Arts Course, for non-matriculated students of both sexes.

The Divinity School

is well manned by regular and occasional professors and lecturers. It represents the whole teaching of the Church of England and is subject to the Bishops.

Degrees are granted in 7 Faculties.

Trinity Medical College, the Ontario Medical College for Women, and the Toronto Conservatory of Music, are colleges of the University, while Trinity College School, Port Hope, is a preparatory school for these Colleges and the University generally.
