An Ordinance to appropriate the sum of Three Hundred and Fifty-eight Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-three Dollars and Five Cents out of the General Revenue of the Colony, for the Contingent Service of the year 1868.

[1st May, 1868.]

MOST Gracious Sovereign, we, your Majesty's most dutiful and Preamble. loyal subjects, the Legislative Council of the Colony of British Columbia, in order to make good the supply, which we have cheerfully granted to Your Majesty, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum hereinafter mentioned, and do therefore most humbly beseech Your Majesty that it may by enacted, and be it enacted by the Governor of British Columbia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

I. That there may be issued and applied out of the General Appropriation of Revenue of the Colony of British Columbia and its Dependencies, not otherwise by Law specially appropriated for or towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty, for the Contingent Service of the year One thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, the sum of Three Hundred and Fifty-eight Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-three Dollars and Five Cents, the said amount being appropriated as follows, namely:
