The population of Chinatown is put down at 20,000, the principal part of which is packed in ten blocks of buildings which might all be placed in Goderich square and still leave plenty of room for the human as well as other inhabitants--rats and vermin of all description-to travel about with ease. But in the midst of all this huddle and dirt, and and want of sunlight, "John" seems to thrive best, and comes out of the filth with a cleanliness that is marvelous and almost incredible.


