PEACE TERMS.

AMSTERDAM, March 5. Russiar undertakes immediately to onclude peace with the Ukraine People's Republic, and to recognize the peace treaty between this State and he powers of the Quadruple Alliance. Ukranian territory will be immediatey evacuated by Russian troops and the Russian Red Guard. Russia will cease all agitation or propaganda against the Government or the pubic institutions of the Ukraine repubic Esthonia and Livonia will be vacuated without delay by the Russian troops and the Russian Red ward. The eastern frontier of Eshonia follows in general the Narova fiver. The eastern frontier of Livoha runs in general through Peipus lake and Pskov Lake to the southstern corner of the latter, then over Luban Lake in the direction of nhoff on the Dvina. Esthonia and dvonia will be occupied by the Geran police till security is guaranleed by their own institutions. Rusia will forthwith release all arrested or deported inhabitants of Esthonia and Livonia, and guarantee the safe eturn of deported Esthonians and lans. Finland and the Aland Isands will also forthwith be evacualed by Russian troops and the Red quard, and Finnish ports by the Rusdan fleet and Russian naval forces.
