

## Daily Questionnaire.

Michael Cashin—To ask Hon. Prime Minister, in the absence of the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, if the man now serving a term of imprisonment in the Penitentiary for a serious offense, was given a contract to cut pulp wood to the amount of \$1,000, and if papers in connection with the same were forwarded to him at the Penitentiary, and if so what is the reason for this, and to ask the name of the contractor.

ask Hon. the Prime Minister, in the absence of the Hon. Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, if the Department of Agriculture and Fisheries sent out a sum of \$400 to a man to cut pit props or supports, and if so what is the explanation of this transaction, and ask the name of the party.

ask Hon. the Minister of Public Works if his attention has been called to the fact that the price of prime has been reduced by a cent a half a pound, and if it is the intention of the Government to support the price to the extent of the loss from this date; if he is aware of the Prime Minister on visiting the Hospital recently, was informed that a patient had a strong complaint against it, and if the Prime Minister took a sample of the said prime away with him and if he has any report on it, and if some one could not be practised someone that would give such people food; and it is true that paying for food is now being furnished with others and others are required to eat prime, and if so what is the reason.

ask Hon. the Prime Minister if attention has been called to the fact that last Wednesday (April 12) in the House there is a strong criticism of the Hon. Mr. C. R. Duder, president of the meeting of the Board of Trade and Commerce, at the same time Manager of Standard Manufacturing Company, who gets large concessions in the price of raw materials, and if he is not the case, ask him if it is not the case that Hon. Mr. C. R. Duder is the President and chief shareholder in this company, if this is the same Hon. Mr. Duder who has been representing the Government in the Upper House session, and is Mr. Duder the same criticism as Mr. Duder, if not why not.

ask Hon. the Prime Minister, in the absence of the Hon. Minister of Marine and Fisheries to lay on the table of the House a statement showing the number of vessels cleared for Labrador Fishery this year, last year and the previous year if these are kept in his Department; if not, to procure them from the Department keeps such records and submit them here.

ask Hon. Minister of Posts and Telegraphs if it is correct that his department pays every year \$23,000 salaries to telegraph repair and maintenance, repairs, improvements, and is he aware that the Reid Co. spends only \$4000 a year for its telegraph lines, salaries, and if that is so, can he make some economies in that service.

ask Hon. the Prime Minister if the intention of the Government is to work on the Badger and Lake Roads this summer, and if so the work to be carried on by contract or in the same fashion as last year.

ask Hon. the Prime Minister, in the absence of the Hon. Minister of Public Works, much the motor trucks used at working at South Branch of the Colony. What has become of them if they have been sold what had received for them; also who acted as agents in the selling of them, and what commission he was paid, or if he paid for this work.

ask Hon. the Prime Minister to lay on the table of the House a statement of the sum of \$4,500 paid by His Honor the Speaker to his visit to Norway two years ago, to state the date on which Hon. Penney left here and the date of return; to lay on the table of the House a copy of his Report, if any, and say what value the country has from his visit and where, if at all, suggestions made by him have been applied in the conduct of the Department.

ask Hon. the Minister of Finance and Customs to table a statement of \$2500.00 paid to A. A. Squires, as travelling expenses as listed in the Contingencies tabled recently.
