Smokers, Go Slow!

The average smoker does not regard seriously anyone who suggested that his habit is harmful. Otherwise he would be a little alarmed at the result of investigations, undertaken to "ascertain the extent to which poison gas manufacture is indulged by the public," mentioned in a recent issue of the British Medical Journal.

Sulphuretted hydrogen and prussic acid are both constant products of the smoker's activity, states the author, Professor Armstrong, though in very minute proportions.

A considerable amount of carbonic oxide, however, is produced. This gas, more familiar under the name of carbon monoxide, is a deadly poison, its actions being to combine with the red coloring matter of the blood and prevent the necessary oxygen being carried to the tissues.

Of the three kinds of smoke—pipe, cigar and cigarette—the last contains by far the smallest proportion of carbon monoxide.

The most important point revealed by these investigations, especially as far as the cigarette produced smoke containing nearly one and a half per cent. carbon monoxide, whereas a

Safety First at Sea.

When dangerous goods, such as acids, matches, or explosives, are carried by vessels they are generally stored on deck to ensure safety of the ship and its cargo, so that in the event of a fire or leakage of acid it can be quickly thrown overboard.

Such cargoes are said to be "jettisoned." This term also applies to cargo, in itself harmless, which is thrown overboard to lighten or relieve a ship in danger or distress.

The covering of the risk against jettison is one of the oldest forms of marine insurance. A thousand years ago it was decreed "that if to lighten a ship in distress, a jettison be made that which is thrown away for the general safety shall be restored by a general contribution."

This law still holds good to-day, and every wise shipper includes the risk against jettison in his insurance policy.
