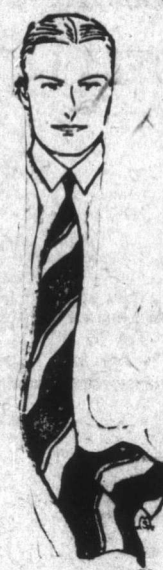

**SO HARD TO SOUND GRATEFUL.**

I said the other day that the supreme test of social ease was the ability to receive a compliment gracefully without either breaking into profuse and obviously insincere disclaimers or being rudely abrupt in one's embarrassed anxiety to change the subject.

It is a searching test, but I have just thought of another quite so rigorous. And that is the ability to accept a gift gracefully and convincingly.

It isn't the easiest thing in the world to be a graceful giver, but I think it is ten times as hard to be a graceful receiver.

**Not To Get Presents But.**

Like all grown up children I love to get presents, but I hate to receive them. If you know what I mean. And if you don't think you know now, you may remember and understand the next time you are called upon to be a receiver.

No matter how much you are pleased with a gift it is hard to sound so. The thought that someone is watching you and trying to see if you really are pleased seems to paralyze your capacity for natural expression.

**Your Voice Sounds Flat.**

You hear your voice take on that queer flat tone, your adjectives sound gushing and insincere in your own ears. Why are words so inadequate

Why does one have to be at such a crucial moment like the golfer who when he particularly wants to make a good stroke is almost sure to get in his own way and make an unusually poor stroke? Why? Well, just because it is a crucial moment and crucial moments are apt to be paralyzing.

Of course when one doesn't like a gift, it is even harder but not very much so. I am sure I have been just as unconvincing when I was pleased as when I wasn't pleased.

I suppose it's just one more example of the difficulty of communication from one heart to another. We talk about communication with Mars. I wonder if it presents any more difficulties than getting some messages through direct from heart to heart.

**Two Ways To Convince.**

Personally, I would rather have a gift come through the mails because it is easier for me to sound convincing in a letter. And if you won't tell any-

one who gives me gifts I will tell you two other methods I have of trying to make my pleasure and gratitude convincing. One is to say how pleased I am to a third person, who I think may tell the giver. Second hand gratitude, like second hand compliments, always seem more genuine. And the other is to be sure to refer to the gift at some later time when I am not under the compulsion of seeming grateful, and when my pleasure will seem more spontaneous and convincing.
