—but roads are a heavy tax—they tax the patience as well as the purse. —It is very difficult to see the silver lining to the literal clouds which overhang and apply themselves without stint upon a great portion of the country but possibly it may be discovered in the impetus which this wretched season will give to the movement for road improvement. The highway in many portions of the West are now simply impassable morasses and quagmires and the need of permanent roads was never so deeply impressed upon all who are directly and indirectly interested. It is to be hoped that the impression will be lasting and lead to some radical and permanent improvements.

The movement made in the State of Massachusetts to instruct the Board of World's Fair Commissioners of Massachusetts to instruct the director general of the exposition the great importance of a comprehensive plan of the construction and maintenance of roads, in which road making and road making machinery can be shown as an object lesson by skilled work men, is in the right direction.
