TO MEASURE FOR PAPER.

Notes which if Followed Makes This a Very Easy Task.

As different paperhangers pursue different methods in hanging paper, so there are various rules and forms for measuring rooms.

An most paper which is trimmed to fit sixteen inches wide and twenty-four feet to a single piece, a piece will contain thirty-six square feet.

Measure the length and height of each wall in feet and multiply. Add together the number of square feet of each wall, getting total number of square feet. Divide this total by thirty-six, which will give you the number of pieces required for side wall.

To allow for waste in matching it is safer to divide by thirty-three instead of thirty-six.

To find number of single pieces required for ceiling, multiply length by width, in feet, and divide by thirty-three.

ANOTHER ADVANCE IN WHEAT

AN ACTIVE DEMAND, WITH REPORTS OF CROP DAMAGE.

Cable is Higher and Toronto Street Railway Lower - Boom on Wall-street.

With Grangers Leading - An Active Market for Live Stock - Provisions Irregular at Chicago.

Friday Evening, May 17.

Toronto Street Railway is weaker to-day, which is said to be account of difficulty of borrowing on stock.

Cable is active and higher, selling at the highest quotations for 18 months.

Consols firmer, closing at 105 3/4 for money, and at 105 13/16 for account.

Canadian Pacific is higher, closing in London to-day at 65 1/2, 8/16 next close at 65 1/2, Erie at 14, Reading at 10 1/4 and N.Y.C. at 105 1/2.

The clearings of Montreal banks for the week are \$12,212,381 as against \$11,878,500 the corresponding week of last year.

The billion in the Bank of England increased \$28,404 during the week, and the proportion of reserve to liability is now 64.34 per cent. as against 65.25 a week ago and 65.96 a year ago.

The gold in the United States Treasury has been increased to \$97,048,000.
