THIRD VISIT TO THE SANDWICH ISLANDS-CONCLU-SION OF THE SURVEY OF THE COAST OF NORTH-WEST AMERICA.

CHAPTER I.

Leave the Coast of New Albion-Arrive off the East Point of Owhyhee-Examine Whyeatea Bay-Vifited by Tamaahmaah-Proceed to Karakakooa Bay-Transactions there-Departure of the Dædalus for New South Wales.

UR progress from the coast of New Albion, still attended with light variable winds, was fo flow, that at noon of Sunday the 15th of December, the shores were yet in fight, bearing from N. 17 E. to S. 69 E.; the former, being the nearest, was distant seven leagues; the observat latitude was 30° 14', longitude 243° 574'.

In the afternoon, the wind blew a moderate Vol. V. gale
