THE EARLY CHURCH: a history of Christianity in the first six centuries, by the late David Duff, D.D., L.L.D., Professor of Church History in the U. P. College, Edinburgh; edited by his son, and just published by T. & T. Clark, has just been received. It contains over 600 Svo pages, in paper and type that are a delight to the eye. It is divided into 56 chapters. Beginning with the preparation for Christ's coming, in the national, social, religious and political condition of the Jews, it goes on to the founding of the church, its progress, the early heresies and apologists, its collision with the Roman power, its triumph, the controversies of the fifth and sixth centuries with the growing doctrine of Papal supremacy. While solid it is far from heavy. Clear in outline, vivid in detail, attractive in style, it passes in review the history of those early times in a picture pleasant to look at and not easily forgotten.
