Prices are very firm, and there is no inclination on the part of sellers to force any class of goods Provided trade continues in the satisfactory condition it is at present, the prospects of higher prices are very bright, as there will be a decided scarcity in some items. WANEY WILTER PINE —There has been a better inquiry, and prices for 1st class wood are firm. 2nd class wood is gradually being worked off, although prices are still low.
