PATIENT—MALE—AGE 61 YEARS.

*"Collapse following operation for Strangulated Hernia. For three weeks following the operation, there was complete collapse, the man knowing nothing for fifteen days. Under the care of two skilled nurses, Mr. B. was bathed every two hours with alcohol, and for SOLE nutriment for three weeks took Panopepton in tablespoonful doses. Most of the time every hour, and the rest of the time every two hours. Recovery was excellent and the patient is now at his usual occupation as Principal of Schools."*
