

THE LATE LIEUT. COLONEL KENNEDY.

Lieut. Col. Arthur Kennedy of the 10th Hussars, was the third son of the late John Kennedy, Esq., of Cuthbert County Down.

Arthur Kennedy entered the British Army as an Esquire in the 24th Foot, in 1803, and rose through the various grades to that of Lieutenant Colonel in 1837.

Mr. Kennedy was uncle to the Rev. J. Kennedy, Missionary at Mersea, C. W.

FROM THE BALTIC.

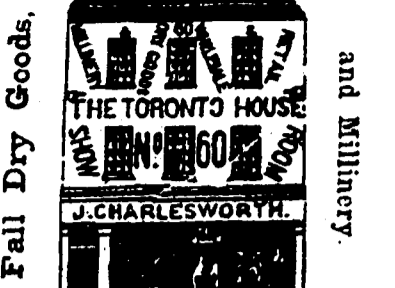
The English fleet near Naragan, was preparing to leave the gun-boats at Elsinore, and is ordered to England.
