## CONVENTION OF COMMERCE BETWEEN CANADA AND POLAND-SIGNED AT OTTAWA JULY 3rd 1935

His Majesty the King of Great Britain, Ireland and the British dominion beyond the Seas, Emperor of India, in respect of the Dominion of Canada, at the President of the Republic of Poland, being desirous of facilitating and extending the commercial relations existing between Canada and Poland, hav resolved to conclude a Convention of Commerce for this purpose, and har appointed as their plenipotentiaries:

Who, after having communicated to each other their respective full power found to be in good and due form, have agreed upon the following Articles:

## ARTICLE 1

Articles produced or manufactured in Canada shall not, on importation into Poland, be subjected to other or higher duties or charges than those put on the like articles produced or manufactured in any other foreign country at the same time the articles enumerated in Schedule A to this Convention produced or manufactured in Canada, shall not, on importation into Polan be subjected to higher duties than those specified in the said Schedule and ship be subjected to the lowest rates of duty which Poland may grant to any other foreign country on the like articles.

## ARTICLE 2

The stipulations of Article 1 of this Convention shall not extend:

- (a) To privileges which are or hereafter may be granted by Poland purely border traffic within a zone not exceeding 15 kilometres with on either side of its customs frontier:
- (b) To privileges granted by Poland to a state by virtue of a Custon. Union with that state;
- (c) To tariff preferences or customs facilities which hereafter may at granted by Poland to Extension I to initiate the second s granted by Poland to Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania or Finland so lot as such privileges are not accorded to any other state;
- (d) To the regime for duties and quotas established temporarily between Polish Upper Siloric and C Polish Upper Silesia and German Upper Silesia by virtue of the German Polish Convention concerning Upper Silesia, signed at Geneva May 15th, 1922.
