**PROTOCOL TO AMEND THE AGREEMENT ON NORTH ATLANTIC OCEAN  
STATIONS SIGNED AT PARIS ON 25 FEBRUARY 1954**

**THE UNDERSIGNED GOVERNMENTS**

CONSIDERING that it is desirable to amend the Agreement on North Atlantic Ocean Stations signed at Paris on 25 February 1954,<sup>(1)</sup>

HAVE AGREED as follows:

**ARTICLE 1**

In Article I of the said Agreement, in paragraph 1—

the number of vessels to be operated by the Kingdom of the Netherlands shall be changed from 2 to 1.

**ARTICLE 2**

In Article I of the said Agreement, in paragraph 2—

all the text following the word “arrange” shall be deleted and a full stop inserted.

**ARTICLE 3**

1. This Protocol shall be open for signature by the Governments which are parties to the said Agreement, and shall come into force on 1 July 1971, provided it has been signed by all of them before that date.

2. Any Government which accedes to the Agreement on or after 13 May 1970 shall at the same time sign this Protocol.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned, being duly authorized thereto, have affixed their signatures on behalf of their respective Governments.

DONE in London, the thirteenth day of May of the year nineteen hundred and seventy, in the English, French and Spanish languages (all three texts being equally authoritative), in a single copy which shall be deposited in the Archives of the International Civil Aviation Organization. Certified copies thereof shall be transmitted by the Secretary General of the Organization to all Governments concerned.
