Interbuild, a biennial event, is Britain's largest trade only exhibition — filling all eight halls of the National Exhibition Centre in Birmingham. In 1987, some 143 000 trade and professional visitors attended.

Solid wood products are now Canada's number one export item to the U.K. at close to \$500 million annually. Building on the success of its 1987 information booth, Canada will exhibit some of the following products in 1989: lumber, soft and hardwood; shingles and shakes; saw-mill products; veneer; plywood; and wood fabrication.
