This exchange program is a university-to-university agreement which covers the exchange of students, especially as teaching assistants. Students are usually expected to have at least B.A. or M.A. qualifications, although undergraduate students are admitted, provided that their qualification is satisfactory. One student / teaching assistant from either institution can stay at the partner university for one academic year. Canadian students may attend a free preparatory course in German at Saarbrücken before working as teaching assistant. There is a tuition waiver and students are paid for their work as teaching assistants, but have to cover any other costs themselves.

Participants are screened and selected by their Departments.

Currently the program is temporarily in question as responsibilities for the program at the university in Canada are being shifted due to internal restructuring.
