part of Mr. Seymous represents his latest attempt to bring improper pressure to bear upon the Government of Canada. It violates the spirit if not the letter of Judge Jackson's Order of June 22, as it violates the most fundamental principles of international law and practice and runs counter to the ordinary principles of justice which Canada and the United States hold in common.

The Embassy urgently requests the Department of State to take all necessary measures to put an end to the threats and improper pressures which Mr. Seymour has brought to bear upon the Government of Canada. In particular, the Embassy requests that this Note and the attached communication from Mr. Seymour be brought to the attention of the Attorney General of the United States.

Given the extraordinary nature of the situation, the Embassy reserves the right to make public this Note and the attached communication from Nr. Seymour, if necessary.

The Embissy of Canada avails itself of this opportunity to remain to the Department of State the assurances of its highest consideration.
