

(b) bodies prescribed by the regulations pursuant to paragraph (2)(d),

or any of such bodies, agents and Her Majesty in that right of such of the guidelines made under subsection (3) as are applicable to public sector suppliers of commodities or services and public sector employees and their employers, and for the administration and enforcement of those guidelines in their application (made in a manner provided for in the agreement or as determined by the government of the province.

(2) The Minister may, with the approval of the Governor in Council, enter into an agreement with the government of a province respecting the regulation, in such manner consistent with the limits and spirit of the guidelines as is provided for in the agreement or by or under any law of the province, of tariffs or subsidies of fees that are or may be established for or relating to the provision of professional services or such classes of professional services as are from time to time specified in the agreement.

(3) The Minister may, with the approval of the Governor in Council, enter into an agreement with the government of a province respecting the regulation, in such manner consistent with the limits and spirit of the guidelines as is provided for in the agreement or by or under any law of the province, of tariffs or subsidies of fees that are or may be established for or relating to the provision of professional services or such classes of professional services as are from time to time specified in the agreement.

(4) For the purposes of this Act and the guidelines

(a) "public sector supplier of commodities or services," "public sector employee," and "public sector employee" mean supplier of commodities and services and employee or commodities and services and employee on whom this Act is binding by virtue of this section or an agreement entered into pursuant to subsection (2) and employee of each supplier and employer respectively; and

(5) "private sector supplier of commodities or services," "private sector employee," and "private sector employee" mean supplier of commodities and services and employee on whom this Act is binding otherwise than by virtue of this section or any agreement entered into pursuant to subsection (2) and employee of each supplier and employer respectively.
