by at least two-thirds of the votes of the members of the Provincial Company present or represented by proxy at a meeting duly called for that purpose, nor until the Superintendent of Insurance has been satisfied by such evidence as he may require that such approval has been given and 5 that the Provincial Company has ceased to do business, or will cease to do business forthwith upon a licence being issued to the Company.
