meddling actively in politics. The letters of Messrs. Chapleau and Ives, and the answers to the same by Messrs. Poirier and Tremblay having been read, This Committee have come to the conclusion that it is not in the public interest that the said A. E. Poirier, Ernest Tremblay and Rémi Tremblay should continue to be employed on the staff of the Hansard, and urge the Honourable Mr. Speaker to notify these three persons that their employment is at an end.

And the Committee adjourned to the call of the Speaker.
