I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of January 12th and to advise you that it is true that Lord Atholstan has offered an award of \$100,000 for a medicinal cure for cancer.

If you wish to offer the cure you have discovered it will be necessary for you in the first place to satisfy a recognized medical faculty or a leading medical society in your own country that there is some scientific basis to justify experimental investigation of the professed cure, and secondly, that any cases successfully treated were, in fact, cases of cancer.
