THE SKIVING PORTRAIT OF BURNS.

Burns was born at Alloway, near Ayr, January 25, 1759. He died at Dumfries, July 21, 1796.

"The simple Bard, rough at the rustic plough,

Hauling the setting sun, sweet, in the green thorn bush;
The soaring lark, the perching red-breast shrill,
