SERVIA'S NEW RAILROAD

(New York Commercial.)

At a point about fifteen miles from the most southern point of the Hungarian frontier Servia is preparing to construct a railroad which threatens to upset all of the carefully laid diplomatic plans of the Austro-Hungarian empire to keep Servia hemmed in both economically and commercially, isolated and wholly dependent on herself.

The new railroad will start at the town of Berza Palanka. Here it will be connected by a bridge with the Rumanian lines and through them with the Russian railroads through northern Bessarabia. Thus Servia has found a way out commercially, independently of Austria-Hungary and is enabled to find a logical means of alliance with Rumania and Russia. 




