✓ Deliverance on the
Reference from the
Presbytery of
Flamboro'

Resumed the consideration of the reference from the Presbytery of Flamboro' in the case of Mr. William Christie, Student,—when it was moved by Mr. Dick, and seconded by Mr. Thornton, that the Presbytery of Flamboro' be authorized to proceed as they shall see fit in this case for the good of the church. It was moved in amendment by Mr. Murray, and seconded by Mr. Fletcher; That Mr. Wm. Christie be required to attend the Theological Institute one term previous to his being taken on trials for license. The vote being taken, the motion was carried by a majority of two.—Mr. Fletcher craved that his dissent from this decision be marked in the minutes.
