Representative Lumsden, of No. 1, was declared duly elected Grand Chancellor for the ensuing year.

For the office of Grand Vice Chancellor, Representatives Sanagan, of No. 12, and Dodds, of No. 4, were nominated. Representative Dodds declined the nomination.

There being but one candidate for the office, the G. M. at A. was instructed to cast the vote of the Grand Representatives for Representative Sanagan.

The Acting Grand Chancellor announced that Representative Sanagan, of No. 12, having received all the votes cast, was duly elected Grand Vice Chancellor for the ensuing year.
