WILD DISORDER IN BRITISH PARLIAMENT.

LONDON, May 22.—In the house of commons this afternoon, Premier Balfour replying to questions on the subject, said he did not consider himself pledged to inaction in regard to colonial preference except so far as parliamentarianism would make an important speech on the fiscal question. Then when Secretary Lyttleton was put up to speak, instead of Mr. Balfour, a storm burst such as has not been heard in the house of commons since the days of the Gladstonian Irish debates.

FROM QUEBEC TO MONCTON.

Two Routes Surveyed For Grand Trunk Pacific. One, Across Country, is 90 Miles Shorter Than the I. C. R., but Will Involve Heavy Grades.

OTTAWA, May 22.—The first report of the transcontinental railway commission was presented to parliament this afternoon. Dealing with the section from Quebec to Moncton, the railway commissioners say that the line would run through a most valuable country. Commissioner Wade recited the objections which were raised that it would not be possible to get a good line route and that the line would be for four degrees, and in a few instances will not exceed six degrees.
