SOLAR AND LUNAR ECLIPSES IN THE YEAR 1826.

- May 21. The Moon totally eclipsed, wholly invisible at Halifax, ♀ at 11h. 2m. morning.
- June 5. The Sun eclipsed, invisible at Halifax ; ♀ at 1h. 40m. evening, in long. 2s 14° 27' ♀'s lat. 1° 5' South.
- October 30. The Sun eclipsed, invisible at Halifax, ♀ at 9h. 7m. evening, in long. 7s 7° 6' ♀'s lat. 1° 30' South.
- Nov. 14. The Moon totally eclipsed, wholly invisible at Halifax, ♀ at 11h. 55m. morning.
- Nov. 29. The Sun eclipsed, invisible at Halifax, ♀ at 7h. 23m. morning, in long. 8s 6° 46' ♀'s lat. 1° 12' North. This eclipse will be very large throughout the North of Europe. In London the Sun will be 6° 38' eclipsed, in Paris 6° 12' on his northern limb.

The Occultations of the Planets and the large stars by the Moon, during the Year 1826, are not numerous.

The Star "2 Alpha Cancri" will be occulted, on the evening of February 20th. The Immersion will take place about 5h 30m p.m. the Emersion about 6h 20m p.m.
