Governor General—His Excellency the Right Honourable SIR JOHN DOUGLAS SUTHERLAND CAMPBELL, K.T., G.C.M.G., P.C., Marquis of Lorne, eld. son of the Duke of Argyll. B. 6 August 1845. Ed. Eton and St. Andrews. M., 21 March 1871, H.R.H. Princess Louise, fourth dau. of Her Majesty Queen Victoria. Represented Argyllshire in the House of Commons from 1868 to 1878. App'td. Governor General of the Dominion of Canada, Nov. 1878.—Government House, Ottawa; Eastern Departmental Building.*
