To an ORDER of the HOUSE OF COMMONS, dated 28th January, 1884; — For a Return showing the number of Home Farms and Indian Instruction Farms closed, or that have ceased to be worked, since the first day of January, 1882.

2. The location of such Farms, and the name and designation thereof.
3. The reason why closed or ceased to be worked
4. The name of the Superintendent, Manager and Instructor.
5. The number of men employed on each Farm in 1882 and 1883, the names and nationality of such employees; specifying particularly the number of Indians so employed.
6. The cost of each Farm for said years, separately.
7. The report of T. P. Wadsworth, Inspector of Indian Agencies and Farms, for 1883, or any Supplementary Report made by him.
